About First Grade:

First grade is an exciting year for both students and families as children's academic and social emotional growth take off. In literacy, students will work with *Fundations*, learn new decoding and comprehension strategies, and study character traits, all while exploring a wide variety of literature, including poetry. Students will also write across genres, including opinion, nonfiction, and narrative writing, while honing their spelling and handwriting skills. In math, students will work on their number sense, and practice addition and subtraction with an array of tools and manipulatives. We will study communities as part of the social studies curriculum and in science we will learn about seasonal changes in the environment, light, sound, plants and animals through experiments and explorations. Finally, first graders will become more responsible and self-reliant, learning how to manage their time and materials independently.

About Ms. Zaharoff:

I am originally from Newton, and grew up going to the Newton Public Schools. I went to the University of Wisconsin and studied film and television while attending Badger football games every Saturday. After spending a few years living in Los Angeles and working in Hollywood on TV shows and movie sets, I decided to change career paths to pursue education.
